Dear President Schulz, dear Mr. Welle,

On behalf of the Parliamentarian Intergroup on Integrity, Transparency, Corruption and Organised Crime (ITCO) we would like to address the following concern:

Article 16 of the new EU staff regulations, in force since January 2014, obliges each EU institution to annually publish information about the senior officials who left the EU administration, as well as a list of the cases of potential conflict of interest, which have been assessed. We wonder when and where the EP will publish this list.

In addition, we would like to know whether the EP will adhere to the recommendations made by the European Ombudsman on EU officials leaving the EU administration. The Ombudsman calls on the EU institutions to publish online the name of the senior official concerned, details of the duties carried out in the EU institution, details of the duties to be carried out in the new position and the assessment and conclusions in respect of potential conflict of interest.

We encourage you to act upon the staff regulations and the recommendation of the Ombudsman, in order to ban the revolving door.
We are looking forward to your response.
